SPECIAL MAINTENANCE INSTRUCTIONS NO RDSO/ELRS/SMI/122 ADDITIONAL INSULATION OVER TAP LEADS

1. OBJECT

Railways have reported feeling off of the paper insulation on the tap leads and formation of a powdery sludge in the neck portion of the freight loco transformers. To overcome this problem it has been decided to provided additional selvedge cotton tape insulation over the paper insulation on the tap leads.

2. INSTRUCTIONS

- Wrap the selvedge cotton tape around each of the tap leads upto .25 mm radial thickness over its full length.
- 2.2 The selvedge cotton tape is to be procured as per the following specification.
 - (i) Governing specification IS: 1923 for "Cotton selvedge tape for electrical insulation purposes."
 - (ii) Nominal thickness $0.125 \text{mm} \pm 0.025 \text{mm}$.
 - (iii) Nominal with 20 mm \pm 1 mm.
 - (iv) Breaking Strength 7.5 kg.
- 2.3 The selvedge cotton taps is to be precured from M/s Kanpur Lathe works, Industrial Area, Habibganj, Bhopal (MP).
