

Common Eligibility Criteria for RDSO Decontrolled Items

i) Railway reserves the right to place bulk/regular order on the bidder* having past credentials of successful supply of tendered item to Indian Railways or any Government concern for at least 35% (cumulatively) of tendered quantity during the last three years prior to and excluding tender opening date. Documentary evidence (such as R/Notes, Inspection Certificate etc.) must be furnished along with the offer evidencing the execution of such purchase orders.

* In case of bidder being an authorized dealer/agent, credentials of OEM will be considered.

ii) Bidders having no past performance as above may be considered for placement of developmental orders, but for consideration of such developmental orders, they must submit details of M & P, testing facilities, STR & QAP, technical manpower available, supply performance (PO Copies, Inspection Certificates, R/Notes etc.) along with their offer.

iii) In addition to above, for Rolling Stock (Electrical) items, if the approved prototype test report as per RDSO specification is not available, the firm has to get the prototype testing successfully conducted by agency authorised by tendering authority before commencing the supply.
