Research Designs & Standards Organisation, Ministry of Railways, Manak Nagar, Lucknow has decided to engage 04 Full Time Contract Medical Practitioners as detailed below for a period up to 30.06.2021 from the date of engagement to manage the COVID-19 pandemic at Extra Divisional Railway Hospital, Manak Nagar, Lucknow.

1. Age will be reckoned as on the date of notification.
2. Monthly Remuneration: Rs. 75,000/-(GDMO). However, as per instructions contained in Railway Board's letter No. No.2020/E(GR)II/1/3 dated 28.04.2021, a reference is being made to State Government authority regarding monthly remuneration being paid by them.
3. **Age:** For candidates from open market- Should not have completed 53 years of age as on 01.04.2021. However, this upper age limit is relaxable upto 5 years for SC/ST and 3 years for OBC candidates.
4. For Retired Medical Officers from State / Central Government including retired Railway doctors - should not have completed 65 years of age as on 01.04.2021 or during duration of contract.
5. Preference will be given in engagement to Retired Railway doctors followed by Retired State/Central government doctors and then to candidates from open market.
6. **How to Apply:** The Interested retired Government Medical Officers of Central/State Government including the retired Railway doctors and Candidates from "Open Market" have to send the scanned copy of their application duly filled and signed in the prescribed format through e-mail along with requisite documents / Certificates in single PDF as mentioned in the application form.

Terms and conditions for engagement of CMPs on Contract (for Retired Railway doctors engaged/ Other than Retired Medical Officers from Central/State Governments)

01. The contract shall be entered into for a period up to 30.06.2021 from the date of engagement. Period of contract is not extendable on any grounds. However, the Railway administration shall reserve the right to enter into fresh contract with the Medical Practitioner for another term.
02. No private practice is allowed during the period of contract.
03. The Contract Medical Practitioner (CMP) will be engaged for daily Full-Time Duty.
04. The retired Railway doctor/ Other than Retired Medical Officers from Central/State Governments who are engaged as Contract Medical Practitioner (hereinafter referred to as CMP), who enters into contract with the railways will not have any claim or right for his / her continuity in service or automatic extension of the term of contract.
05. During the validity of the contract, the CMP will be at liberty to terminate the contract for betterment of his / her career or on any other grounds by giving 15 days notice to the Railways. The contract can also be terminated by the Railways at any time during the period of contract by giving 15 days notice without assigning any reasons whatsoever. Contract shall also be terminated, if the CMP is found to be mentally or physically incapacitated.
06. Selected candidate shall agree to perform all duties as and when assigned to them by administration. Any refusal or non-compliance to the above is liable for termination of contract.
07. The candidate will give a self-declaration stating that they are not suffering from any chronic disease or comorbidity that will put them at increased risk in a situation where they have to deal with unscreened patients.
08. At the time of entering into contract, the CMP shall produce certificates of his / her **character and antecedents from two gazetted officers of the Central / State Government.** The retired Railway doctor shall be exempted from this condition.
09. At the time of entering into contract, the CMP shall produce original certificates for proof of his / her date of birth and educational qualifications.
10. CMP shall produce certificates of Post MBBS skill enhancement courses done, if any.
11. Copy of Aadhar Card and PAN Card are also to be submitted with Application Form. No document will be accepted on a later date.

12. The monthly Rate of Remuneration for CMPs is as under:

13. In the event of un-authorized absence of Contract Medical Practitioner from duty or absence from duty for a period of exceeding the period stipulated in the contract, there shall be proportionate deduction from remuneration.

14. CMPs are not entitled for railway accommodation. However, if there is need they may be provided quarter subject to availability. In case Railway accommodation is provided to the CMP, an amount equivalent to HRA and License Fee of the accommodation so provided shall be deducted from the monthly fee admissible to the CMP. (The remuneration specified above includes House Rent Allowance and transport allowance).

15. The CMP shall be governed in respect of matters not referred to in these terms and conditions by any orders / amendments to the terms of contract issued by the Railways from time to time.

16. The doctor engaged as CMP shall not accept any other appointment, paid or otherwise, and shall not engage himself/herself in a practice of any kind during the period of contract.

17. The CMP selected should not perform / involve in any activities that would be considered against the interest of Medical Department / Railways and, if found, his/her services will be terminated immediately.

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
