



M/s Indian Oil Corporation Ltd. ask for change the limit of Total Acidity from 1.0 (for VG-32, VG-68, and VG- 220) to "TO BE REPORT" only and agreed with all other remaining parts of specifications	(i) Total Acidity is the key parameter for any lubricant as acidity may cause of corrosion in lubricating parts. Therefore a limit to control the acidity in lubricating oil is necessary. (ii) As per CVO RDSO Note No. CVO/RDSO/Confdl/2020 dated 23.06.2020 and 21.08.2020, Limit for the pass or fail for any testing parameter must be incorporated in the revised specification
